Christmas 2012 Year in Review

Because of you...

New Delhi: Surya and Stella travelled to New Delhi in November. They preached to many, and baptized 14 Punjabi and Muslim youth. God is doing a mighty work among the young people all over India!!



Bombay: God showed Himself mighty in Bombay this year. We brought on 5 new missionaries: Surya, Stella, Nilish, Guudu and Laxni. Twelve from Saint Andrew Baptist Church in Panama City, FL travelled to Bombay in August. Under the leadership of Cameron Skinner, the Pardhi, an unreached/unengaged people group (UUPG), was engaged and over 170 prayed to receive Christ for the first time. Under pastor Surya's leadership two more unreached people groups were engaged: Prabhu Pantane, and Kurla (a Muslim group). Thousands heard the Gospel for the first time—60 more salvations (September-current).

Over nine-hundred cancer patients were visited, heard the Gospel, prayed for and received a New Testament Bible.

Twenty widows daily are being fed. Four-hundred forty (440) widows have been fed through NAM this year.

Five orphans are being cared for (schooling, food, medical, and clothing) most importantly, they learn of their Heavenly Father's love.

Three-hundred prostitutes from the Red Light District received counseling from Stella and 18 were rescued and relocated.

Andhra Pradesh: Pastor Surya travelled to Vizak and preached for thousands of people. Many people were saved and healed of various diseases.

Pastor Darsi reaches the unreached Banjara Sikh and Banjara Muslim people groups. He and his team of nine pastors journeyed to Kerala to attend the Missionary Conference taught by Lynn Briley and Floyd Skinner.



Tamil Nadu

Pastor Thomas engaged two tribal areas in Tamil Nadu. These areas are located in the jungles and are 'unreached' by society and the Gospel. The literacy level is 0%. Out of 140 families, 10 families have accepted Jesus Christ. This is a hard area to reach, spiritually (because of their practice of black magic) and geographically. Continue to Pray for the unreached in Tamil Nadu.



Kerala-Under the leadership of Cameron Skinner and Lynn Briley of Saint Andrew Baptist Church, we lead a team of 14 into the jungles of Kerala to reach the Vetan people. These people were an unreached/unengaged people group and very receptive to the Gospel. God raised up a pastor among them and his entire household accepted Jesus before our very eyes. Now 20 new believers attend this 'Jungle Church' weekly.

Not Ashamed Ministries Missionary Training School, under the administration of Johnson, is preparing to graduate its second group of missionaries. This is a three year Missionary Training Program. We will put 13 new missionaries in the field next year.

Pastor Robert reported that 8,000 heard the Good News to include 2,600 hospital patients. Eighty (80) new believers.



Over 2,200 Unreached groups still need to hear the saving news of Jesus!

****India Site Survey:** NAM Asian director, Rajen and NAMI Missionary Training School Principle, Johnson travelled to the states of: Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Madhya Pradesh. More than 300 heard the Gospel with 60 salvations. A total of 29 Unreached People Groups were engaged, including the Hindu Maoist communist group. We are confident that God will give us every area our feet have stepped (Joshua 1). Dubai, UAE: Pastor Rajen oversees two church congregations and a Missionary Training School in Dubai: Bethany Worship Center and Massafi and Bethany Missionary Training School. Eighty-four new believers were baptized.

Abu Dhabi outreach using sports program and arts as street evangelism tools.

Fourteen new missionaries graduated Not Ashamed Ministries Bethany Bible School (3 year program). This is an additional 14 missionaries available for immediate ministry service.

11 Year Old raises \$1,100 for India:

Bethany decided she wanted to raise \$1,100 for our missionaries in Bombay to have independent transportation. This would save them about **4-5 hours** a day they spend taking public transportation. In turn, more time in the field. She drew 4 different Christmas card designs and sold them in packs of 12. Within 1 month, she raised \$1,100. God is so faithful! Praise the Lord that she is using her gift for His glory.



Immediate Goals for 2013:

"...To the Jew first..." We have already begun prayer and preparation to reach out to two unreached Jewish groups in India: The Bombay Jews and Cochin Jews.

Building Project- In February, we are breaking ground on a missionary training school building in Kerala. October we are graduating the second group of missionaries. We pray to be able to put all 13 in the field.

Widows- Inaugurating the Martha Whittemore-Sharit (Kerala) and the Theresa Gravette (Bombay) Food Pantry for Widows.

Mission Trips: Two trips scheduled in June and October with Saint Andrew Baptist Church teams.

Unreached People: To reach and plant churches in 15 unreached areas.
